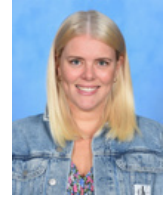
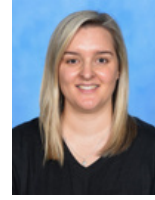

What we are learning this Term:

Literacy



In Literacy the 3/4s are focusing on:

- Identifying the main idea in a text using supporting details.
- Recognising the author's purpose for writing a text.
- Making predictions about a text using clues from the title, pictures, and content.
- Making inferences and text-to-text connections when reading narrative stories.
- Planning, drafting, and publishing a narrative using correct text structure, language features, and writing techniques.
- Using learnt strategies to write interesting and increasingly complex sentences.
- Rereading and editing writing for meaning, structure, spelling, and punctuation.
- Writing using clearly formed joined letters with developing fluency.
- Exploring the origins of words in the English language.

Maths



In Maths the 3/4s are focusing on:

- Developing a range of addition and subtraction strategies to improve accuracy and efficiency.
- Identifying and describing different types of angles.
- Exploring introductory algebra concepts by recognising patterns and solving simple number problems.
- Developing their understanding of money, including calculating totals and change in real-life contexts.
- Developing understanding around 3D shapes and their properties.

Integrated Studies



In Integrated Studies the 3/4s are focusing on:

- Investigating the properties of materials and exploring how liquids and gases behave.
- Observing how heating and cooling can cause changes of state
- Examining how properties of different materials influence how they are used in everyday life.
- Exploring friction, gravity and magnetism and how these forces affect the motion of objects

Wellbeing



In Wellbeing this Term we are focusing on:

- developing positive coping strategies for managing big emotions and building resilience.
- Explore help-seeking strategies, learning when it is important to ask for help and identifying trusted people they can turn to for support.
