MR PELL'S RETIREMENT CELEBRATION

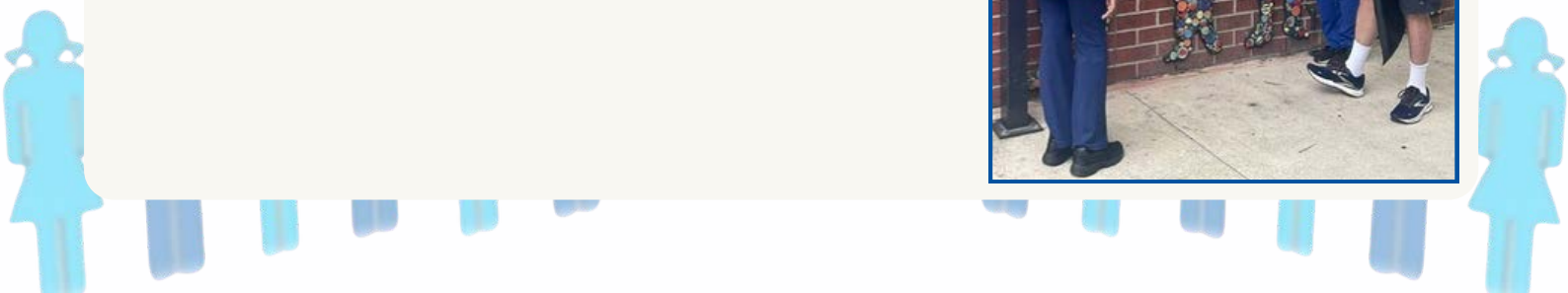

BUNNINGS BBQ FUNDRAISER

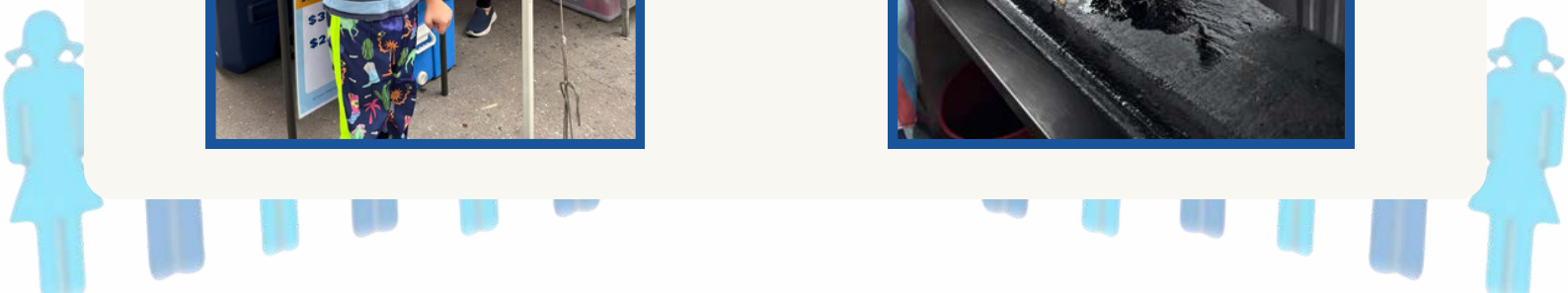

MOTHER'S DAY MORNING

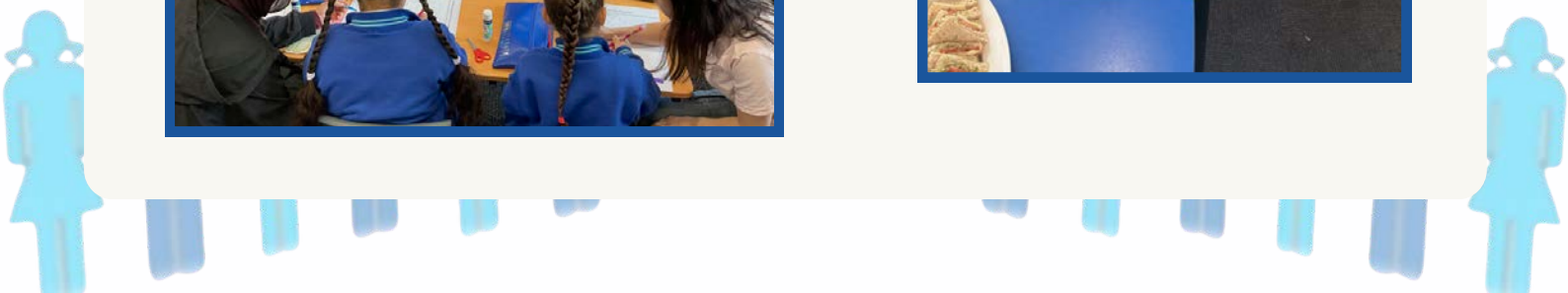

GRADE 4/5 SCIENCE FAIR



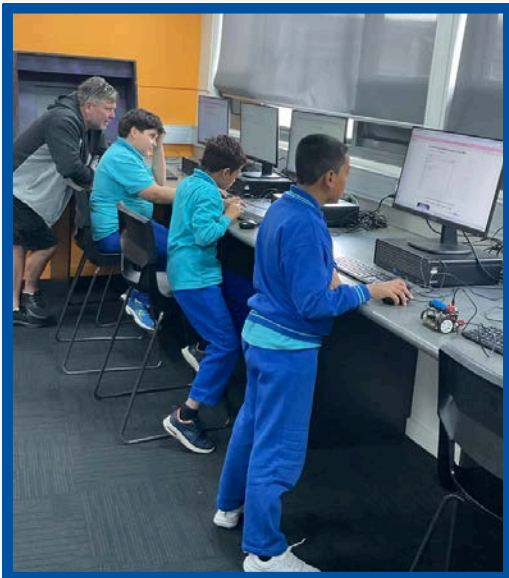
A big thank you to Glenroy College for hosting our Grade 4 and 5 students at their annual Science Fair.

CROSS COUNTRY

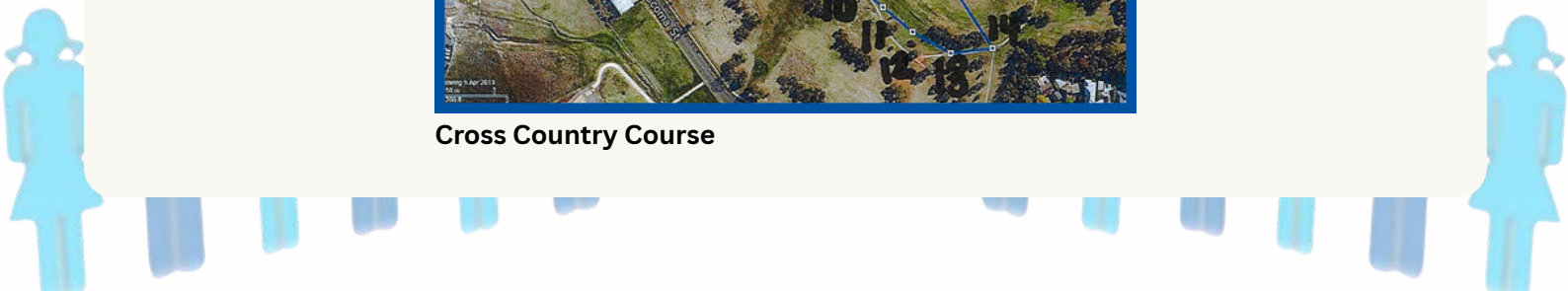

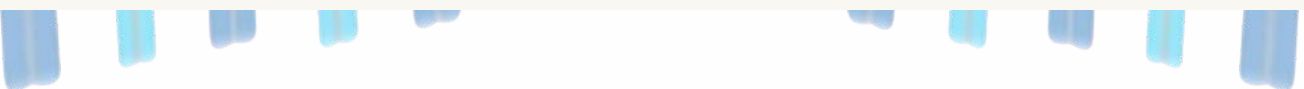
OUTDOOR LEARNING SPACE - BEHIND B.E.R
