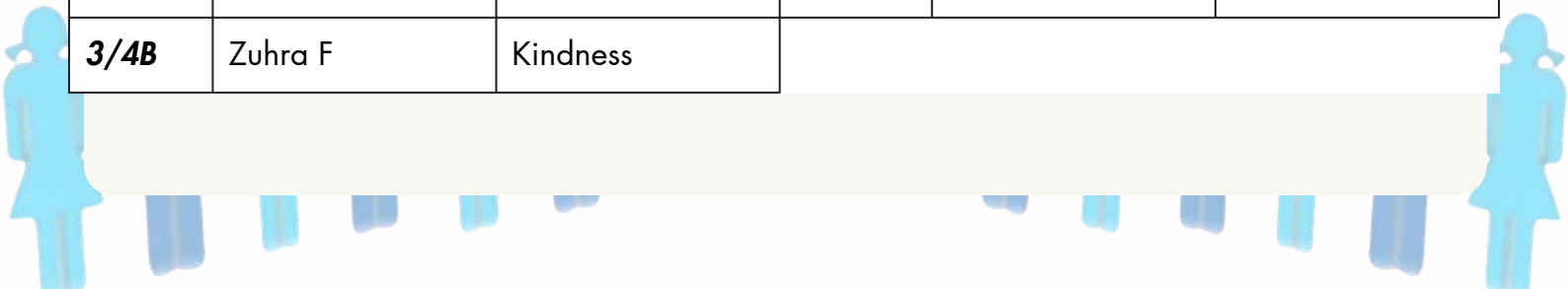

SCHOOL UNIFORM



Our school uniform is worn by all students from Foundation to Year Six. Just like any sports team, collectively wearing the same uniform fosters a sense of belonging and connection.

School uniforms show that we all belong to the same school and are part of our school community. When we are out in public at sports events or excursions, it also shows the wider community that we are a collective group.

It's important that we are wearing the correct items.

Royal blue and aqua are our school colours. If students want to wear a long sleeve top under a dress or polo tshirt, it must be white, royal blue or navy. Likewise, if leggings are worn under dresses or shorts, they must be white, royal blue or navy. No other colours are to be worn.

If students need uniform items, they can be purchased from our supplier FCW. We also have some donated items that can be purchased at a reduced cost.

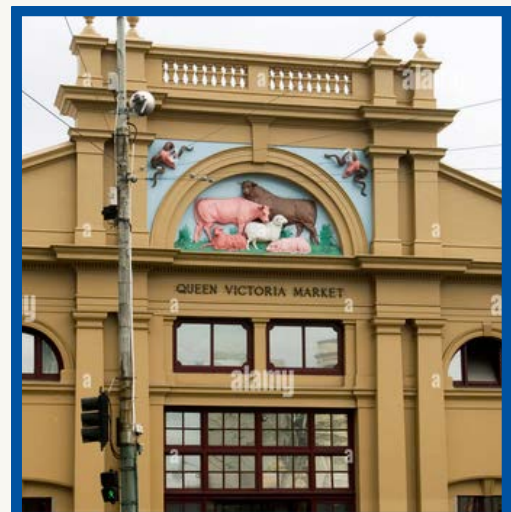

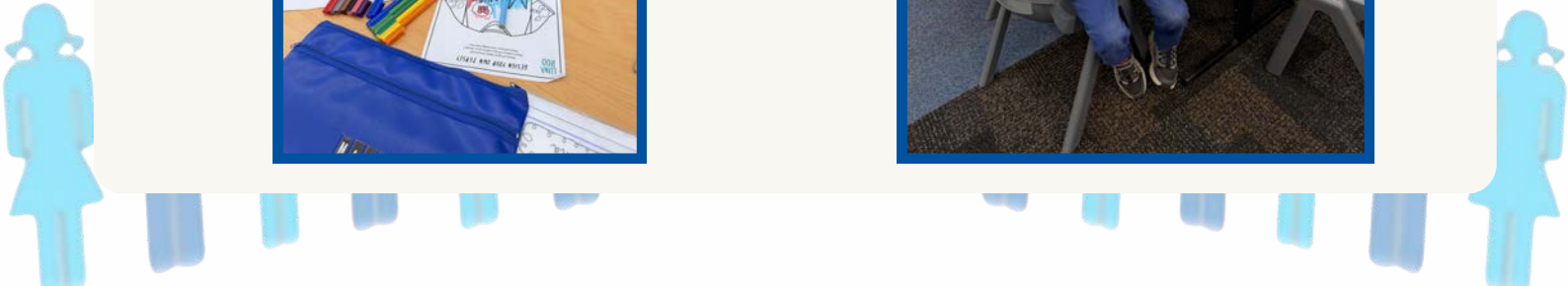
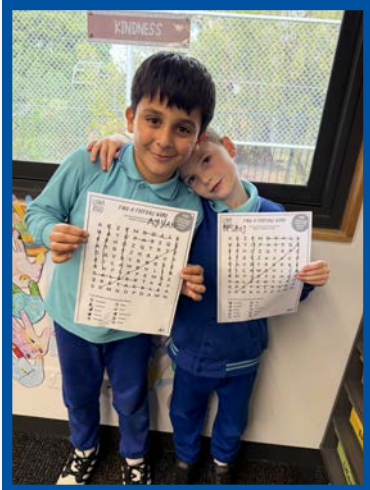




NATIONAL SIMULTANEOUS STORYTIME

We enjoyed celebrating this exciting event at school and sharing the magic of the Luna Roo story with our students.

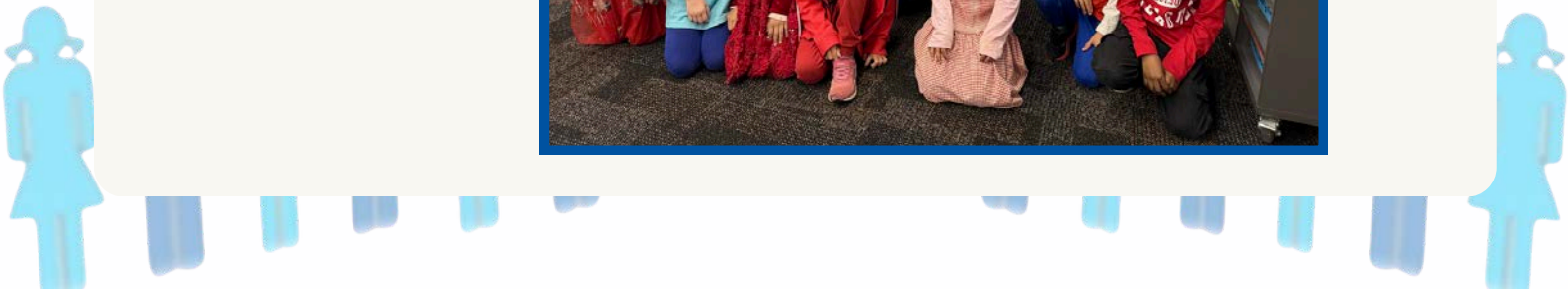




RED SHIELD APPEAL

It was wonderful to see so many students showing their support by wearing red for the day. Thank you to everyone who contributed and helped make a positive difference in the lives of others.

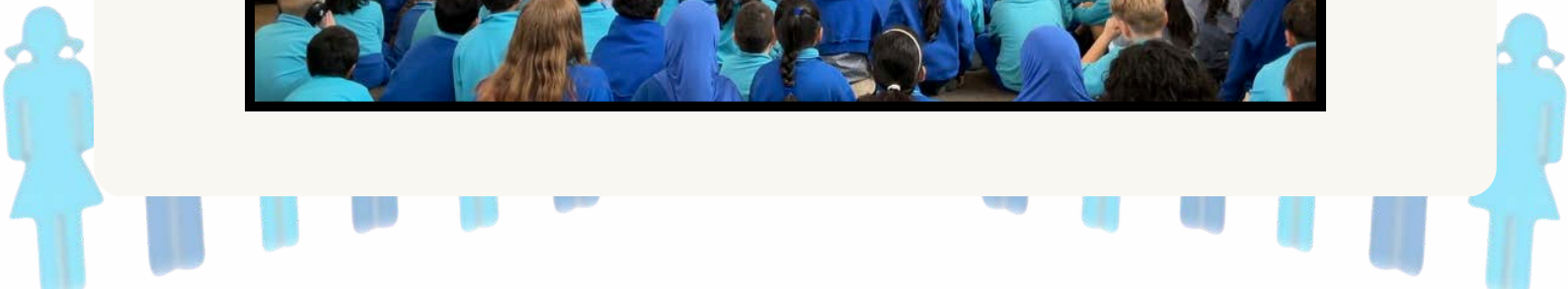




DANCE SHOWCASE

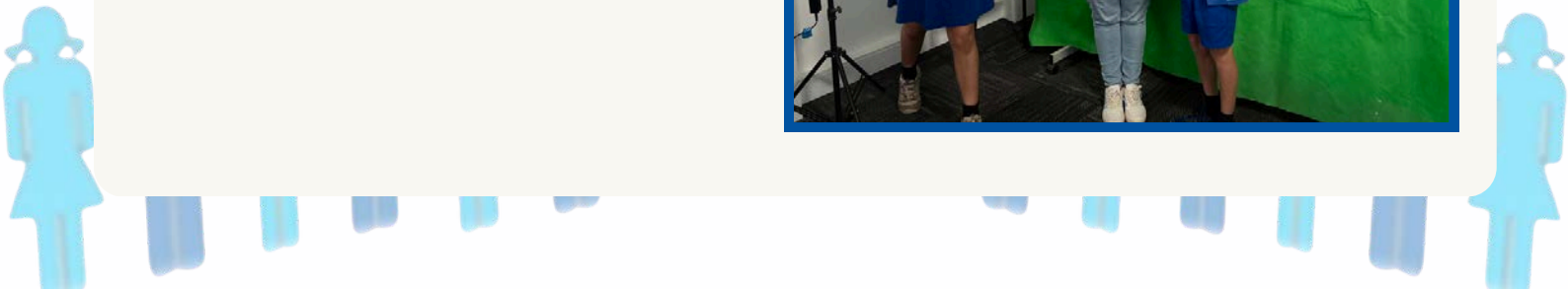


MEDIA CLUB IN THE SPOTLIGHT

SOCCER GALA DAY

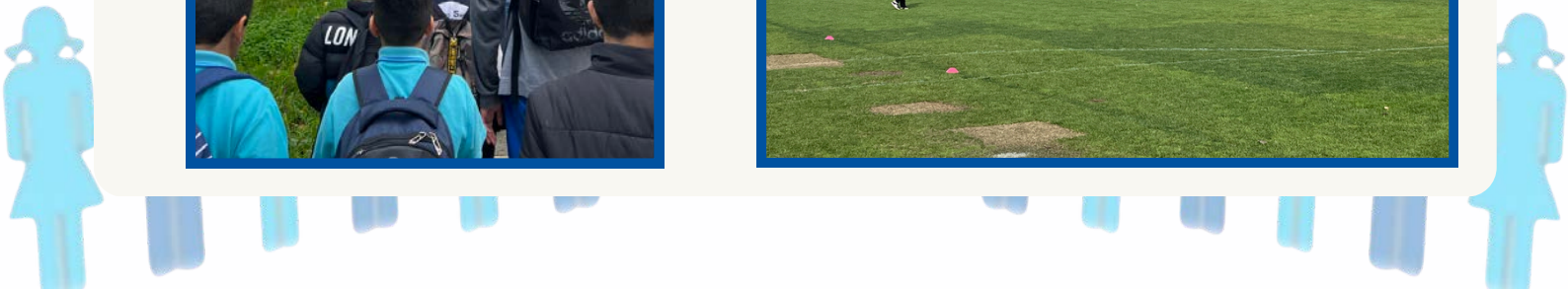
Selected Grade 5/6 students recently enjoyed a fantastic Soccer Gala Day hosted by John Fawkner College.

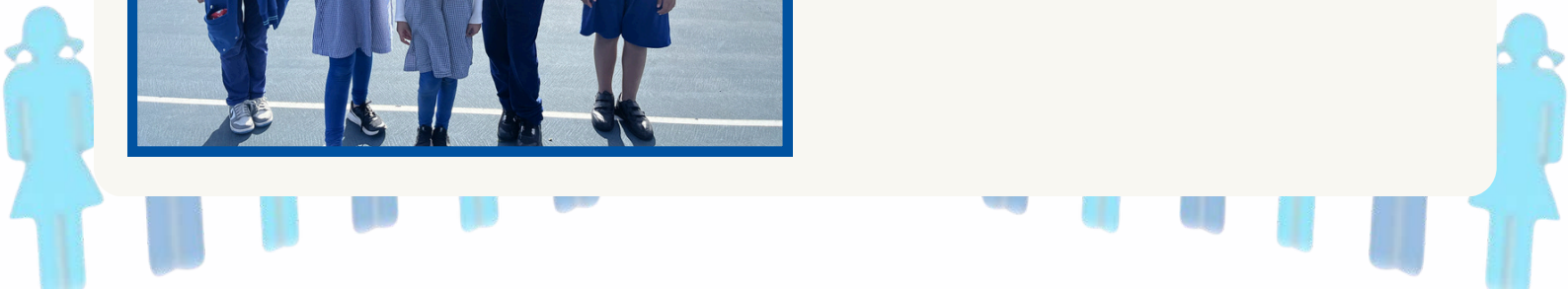
INTERSCHOOL SPORTS

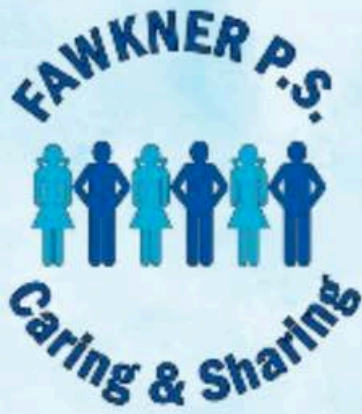

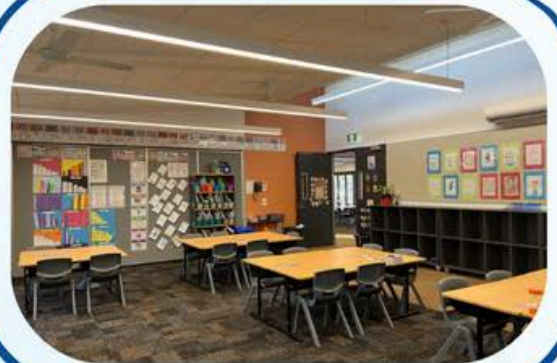

General daily advertised activities are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances, at the discretion of the service coordinator.



Serious stuff!

Medical Management Plan & Medication



All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, food/chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide:

- a completed Medical Management Plan with a colour photo
- necessary medication

Please note it is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking that these are provided.

In the interests of child safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication or medication not be supplied.

Child Care Subsidy

Please note that subsidised hours are calculated and allocated by Centrelink on a fortnightly basis. Check Centrelink for eligibility.



Fortnightly childcare subsidised hours

Each session is calculated using the full service operational hours, not the hours attended by the child.

Additional Child Care subsidy will not cover any hours beyond the subsidised hours per fortnight.

*Less than 5 days from the start of the booking (120 hours from the start of the session).

When making additional bookings, the \$10.00 fee is eligible for the Child Care Subsidy, which means you may only need to pay the gap, depending on your families' circumstances.
